

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (4.5.2016 L119/38 Official Journal of the European Union EN), I inform you that:

3. Your personal data are processed for the purpose(s) of:

- Realization of teaching tasks, other statutory tasks of the school and organizational tasks organizational tasks resulting from the Educational Law Act of December 14, 2016. (Journal of Laws 2021, item 1082, as amended) on the basis of (Article 6(1) c RODO),
- Fulfillment of legal obligations incumbent on the ZPSM in Kielce,
- execution of agreements concluded with contractors, in other cases, personal data processed on the basis of previously granted consent in the scope and purpose specified in the content of the consent.

4. in connection with the processing of data for the purposes referred to in pt. 3 the recipients of your personal data may be:

- public authorities and entities performing public tasks or acting on behalf of public authorities, to the extent and for the purposes that result from the provisions of generally applicable law;
- other entities which, on the basis of relevant contracts, process personal data for which the Administrator is the ZPSM in Kielce.

5. your personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the purposes specified in pt. 3, and after that time for the period and to the extent required by the provisions of generally applicable law.
6. You have the right of access to the content of your data and the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to data portability.
7. If the processing of personal data is based on a person's consent to the processing of personal data (Article 6(1)(a) of the RODO), you have the right to withdraw this consent at any time. Such revocation shall not affect the compliance of the processing carried out on the basis of consent before its revocation with the applicable law.
8. If you become aware of unlawful processing of your personal data at the school, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority competent in matters of personal data protection.
9. Where the processing of personal data is based on the consent of the data subject, your provision of personal data to the Administrator is voluntary.
10. It is mandatory for you to provide personal data in a situation where the premise for the processing of personal data is a provision of law or a contract concluded between the parties.
11. Parents/participants have the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Data Protection Authority.
12. Personal data shall not be processed in an automated manner.
13. personal data are not subject to profiling.
